
HUMAN TRAFFICKING RESPONSE

Identify & Act

<u>Identify Red Flags</u>

- The patient is unwilling to answer questions about their injury/illness
- The patient provides an inconsistent or scripted medical history
- The patient cannot provide their identification or address
- The patient is accompanied by someone who does not allow the patient to speak for themselves



Complete Primary 4 Question Screening

- 1. Is somebody holding your passport or ID?
- 2. Have you provided sex for money, food, shelter, or other needs?
- 3. Does someone require you to pay part of your earnings to them?
- 4. Is the job/pay different than what you were promised?



Report to a HEART Champion

- The HEART Champion will ask secondary screening questions utilizing the trauma-informed care approach found in the PEARR tool
- If the screening is positive and the patient gives their consent the HEART champion will make a report to the NY Statewide Central Register





*DO NOT contact law enforcement directly unless patient gives their permission, or they are in imminent danger
