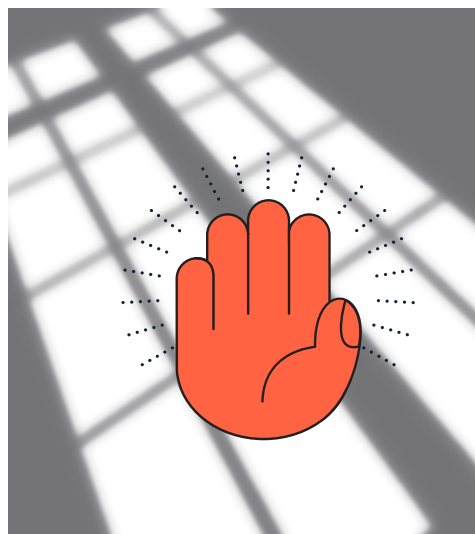


HUMAN TRAFFICKING RESPONSE

Identify & Act

Identify Red Flags

- The patient is unwilling to answer questions about their injury/illness
- The patient provides an inconsistent or scripted medical history
- The patient cannot provide their identification or address
- The patient is accompanied by someone who does not allow the patient to speak for themselves



Complete Primary 4 Question Screening

1. Is somebody holding your passport or ID?
2. Have you provided sex for money, food, shelter, or other needs?
3. Does someone require you to pay part of your earnings to them?
4. Is the job/pay different than what you were promised?



Report to a HEART Champion

- The HEART Champion will ask secondary screening questions utilizing the trauma-informed care approach found in the PEARR tool
- If the screening is positive and the patient gives their consent the HEART champion will make a report to the NY Statewide Central Register



***DO NOT contact law enforcement directly unless patient gives their permission, or they are in imminent danger**
